Stages in a problem-solving process

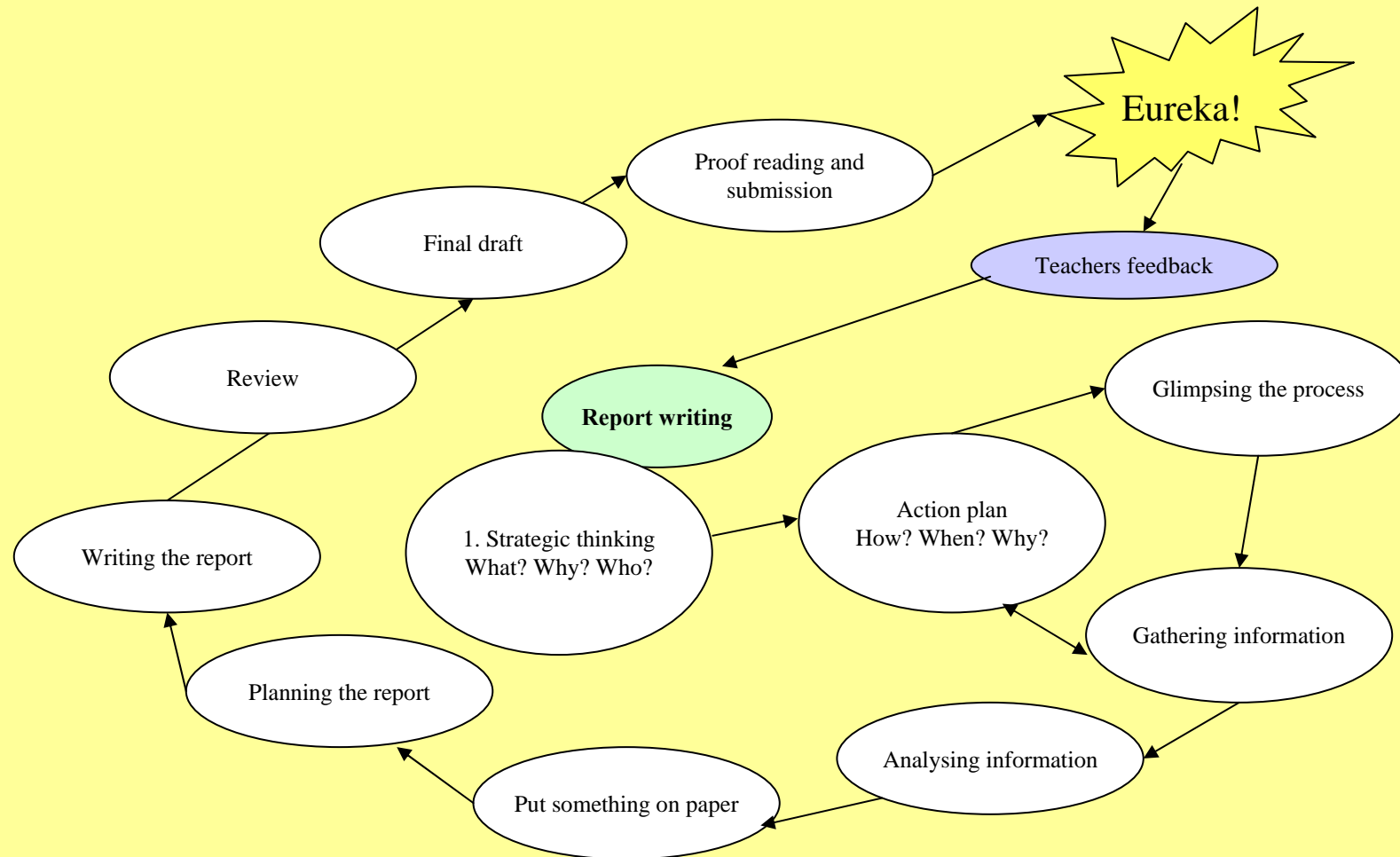
- **group formation**

- **planning** (clarifying goals, choosing a methodology for solving the problem)
- **implementation** (data collection, evaluation of data, problem solving)
- **presentation of the results**
- **evaluation**

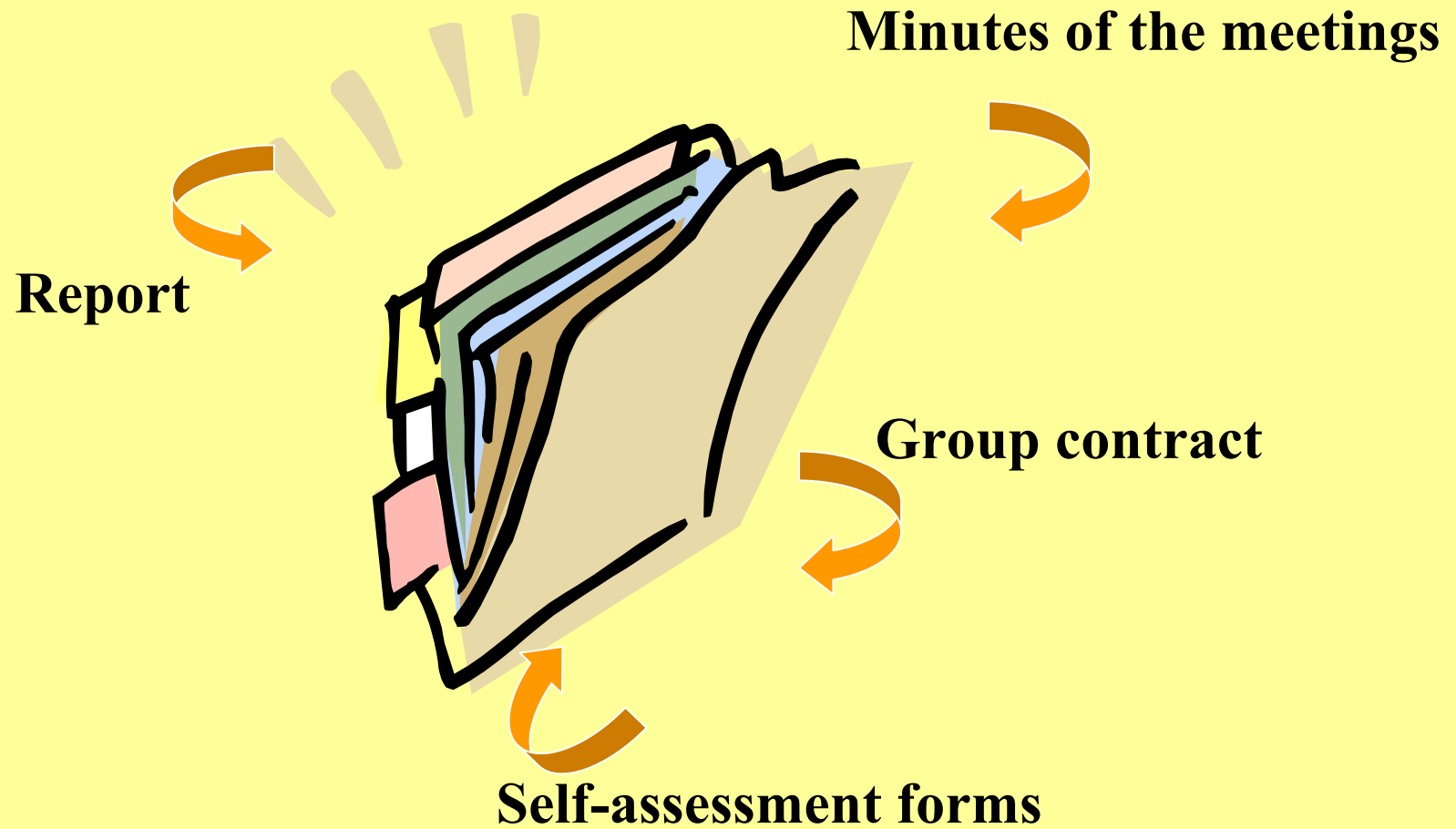
Step-by step procedure

- appointing a chairperson/minutes taker/reporter
 - brainstorming
 - setting up hypotheses
 - distributing tasks
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- information search
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- verifying hypotheses
 - consulting the teachers
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- the group meets again
 - signing a contract
 - further planning and division of tasks
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- writing the first draft
 - writing the final version
 - delivering a presentation
